Paper Prescription Requests & the NHS App

All areas of the NHS continue to progress the ambitions of the NHS Long Term Plan, and the recently published NHS 10 Year Plan. These plans commit to eliminate paper prescriptions via the shift from 'analogue to digital'.



In the practice's ambition to support this work as well as contribute to environmental factors, the surgery will no longer be accepting paper prescription requests from Tuesday 11 November 2025.



The practice **encourages patients to use the NHS App** where possible which is the quickest and safest way to request repeat medication. This is because patients are able to choose from their already listed medications on the app, and these requests then go directly into the clinical system for review by a prescriber.

For anyone not already signed up to the NHS App - we recommend signing up on or after Tuesday 11 November 2025 to prevent having to re-register after the practice merger with Burnham & Berrow Medical Centre.
